Maynard Konechne, the South Dakota EMSA political advocate, joined the North Dakota delegation on March 30, 2023, in Washington, D.C. to speak with our legislatures on issues concerning EMS professionals nationwide. Konechne, along with Corey Johnson, the Director of the Williston, ND, ambulance service, and Christopher Mahoney, the training officer for Williston met with representatives of the elected officials in their respective offices. Konechne states that it "was a productive day of meetings and gaining new friends and colleagues from North Dakota." South Dakota Senate and House legislatures were encouraged to join the EMS Caucus, so they will have a better understanding of the problems endured by EMS personnel.


"If Today Was Your Last Day"
