NewsCenter1: Rapid City Fire Department Holding Class for Aspiring First Responders

NewsCenter 1 published an article titled "Rapid City Fire Department holding class for aspiring first responders" on April 1, 2024. This article, written by David Azadi Scott, highlights the Rapid City Fire Department's registration for its upcoming summer Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course.

Open to all, the program, running from June to September, aims to train aspiring EMTs for local fire department ambulance crews. Jason Reitz, EMS training captain, stressed the need for trained EMTs in the region and the course's role in meeting this demand. Sessions, held two nights a week and one weekend a month, offer flexibility. Interested individuals can apply via the Rapid City Fire Department's website, streamlining enrollment for aspiring EMTs and addressing the need for trained first responders in the community.


Santel Communications Donation to Wolsey Ambulance project Fund


Sanford Academic EMS Outreach Spring 2024


